
























Our Cosmetology Program

Supplies... What will I need to be successful in Grade 9?


- A positive attitude & a solid work ethic ©
- 1 or 2 binders, loose leaf for each binder
- 3 packages of subject dividers
- Ruler with metric and imperial measures
- Geometry set that has a compass/protractor
- Scientific Calculator that has a X² and square root key V
- Pencils, Pens (blue/black), pencil crayons, white eraser
- Gym clothes (It is <u>mandatory</u> that students change down for PE.)
- Inside shoes for gymnasium
- Highlighters
- Ear buds or headphones

Optional Supplies:

- Scissors, graph paper
- Thesaurus/dictionary
- Graph paper

* CTF courses may have additional costs/supplies required.

Students will be informed of these supplies on the first day of class.



What if I am ABSENT from school?

- We expect all absences to be <u>called in</u> by your parent/guardian before 11:30 am.
- If you are absent and there is not a call in to notify the front office, that evening a call will be made to your house.
- If there is no communication from your parents, you will be called down to serve a DT at noon hour.
- You will be accountable for your attendance and lates, in all classes, including options, which means it is your responsibility to make-up your missed work.

Late Policy What if I am *late*?

- Students will receive 5 free lates at the start of each semester.
- A call from the parent/guardian about you being late is appreciated.
- If there is not a call-- then you will have a minimum 15 minute detention at noon.
- Students will need to have a note from the office to get into class.

What if I need to leave school part way through the day?

A parent/guardian is to sign you out from school. The parent/guardian is to come to the office, sign a sheet and speak to the secretary. Once this has occurred, there is a phone call to the classroom and the teacher is notified that you will be leaving.

Am I allowed to leave the school during my break(s) or on noon hour?

There is no need to leave the building during the four minute break; therefore, you are not allowed to leave the building. At noon, Hilltop operates an open campus and you can leave the school grounds.

- 1. All Alberta Gr. 9 students write Provincial Achievement Tests in LA, Math, Science, and Social.
- Results from PAT's provide info about what students know and can do in relation to provincial standards. These results can be used to improve learning opportunities for students.
- 3. Students must be on an ISP (Individualized Student Plan) to receive modifications or adaptations to their PAT. ISP's help to support student learning when learning and/or physical disabilities are present.
- 4. All students MUST write their PAT's unless they have been excused from writing by the Superintendent.

PURPOSE OF THE HLAT RESOURCE

The Highest Level of Achievement Test (HLAT) in English writing was developed for students enrolled in grades 1 through 9. In Northern Gateway, students in grades 2 through 9 will complete the assessment in the fall and in the spring of each school year.

The primary purpose of the resource is to:

- provide students with an opportunity to demonstrate their writing skills on a timed, draft writing task.
- support teachers in schools across the Division in demonstrating consistency and accuracy when judging student writing in relation to the learning outcomes outlined in the English Language Arts Programs of Study.

MATH INTERVENTION/PROGRAMMING INSTRUMENT - MIPI


The Hilltop High School Mathematics Department implemented the use of the Math Intervention/Programming Instrument, or MIPI for short.


Within the first days of classes, Mathematics 9 students complete a short assessment on math concepts they learned in their last school year.

The results will not count toward students' grades and there is no need to study ahead of time.

This tool is simply a way to help teachers know where each student is in their math knowledge and skills and provide necessary supports for all math learners.






