Alberta High School Diploma Requirements:

- Minimum 100 credits
- Must include:
 - English (at the 30-level)
 - Social Studies (at the 30-level)
 - Math (at the 20-level)
 - Science (at the 20-level)
 - CALM 20
 - Phys Ed 10
 - 10 credits at the **30-level** (**other than** English and Social)
 - 10 credits in any combination from: CTS; Phys Ed; Fine Arts; 2nd Language; RAP; Work Experience.

STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS

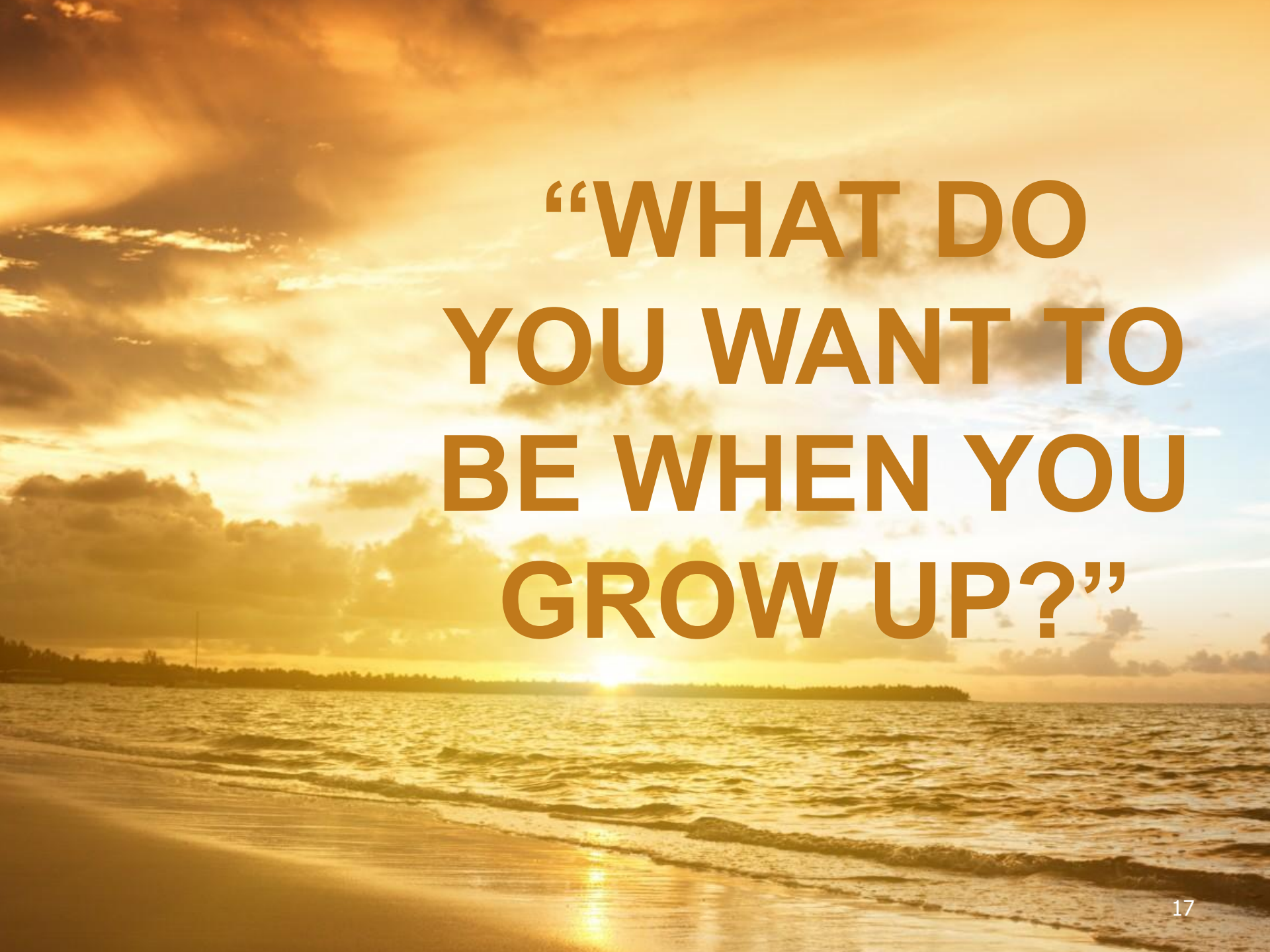
- **Student Ownership of Success**

- Assignment completion
- Preparing for Diplomas - 30% this year
- Communication between parent, student and teachers
- Parent/teacher interviews

In a unique situation:

What is ApplyAlberta?

ApplyAlberta is a secure online application system that allows students to apply to one or more of Alberta's public colleges, universities, and technical institutes through a common starting point, and to authorize the transfer of their Alberta high school or post-secondary transcripts.

It is a good idea to have a print out of your Detailed Academic Report to refer to courses, completion dates and marks.

The process of signing up for ApplyAlberta takes about 30 minutes, so give yourself lots of time! See Mrs. Trebilcock if you need assistance but also check the Gr 12 Google Classroom for a “how to” tutorial

Apply Alberta

How does ApplyAlberta benefit students?

- Makes it easy for students to apply to one or more post-secondary institutions. The first time students use ApplyAlberta they will create a profile with their personal and academic history. This information is then filled in automatically on each of the Alberta post-secondary applications they complete.
- Facilitates the transfer of academic transcripts. Within ApplyAlberta, students authorize institution(s) to request the transfer of their Alberta Education high school and/or post-secondary transcripts. Students will not be charged a fee for transcripts transferred through ApplyAlberta.
- Speeds up the application process. The ability to apply to multiple institutions without having to re-enter basic information and to authorize transcript transfers will save students time.

Financing Education: A big investment

2025 stats (RBC) pegged the cost of a four-year degree (including tuition, academic fees, expenses and living costs) at \$101,300. A big increase from previous years.



Scholarship Assistance

- Year after year, numerous scholarships fail to receive a **single** application.
- When in doubt: **Apply!**
- Think about it this way: A few hours of work assembling letters and filling out a form could translate into **thousands of dollars.**
- Honour your hard work at school:
Research and apply!



Speaking of scholarships, many may require the following elements (in addition to individual application requirements):

- **Reference letters from teachers, coaches, employers, people who supervise you for volunteer hours.**
- **Evidence of long-term volunteering**
- **A Resume**
- **A transcript**



THE VALUE OF BUILDING A RESUME

- You need a resume.
- Student Services is happy to help.

- Cover Letter: *Why hire me?*
- Resume Basics:
 - Name + Contact Information
 - List highest level of achievement, workplace certificates
 - Identify and Detail your Prior Work Experience
 - Identify volunteerism and extra-curriculars
 - List references

RUTHERFORD SCHOLARSHIP

**Online application only

***Can be used even if a break between high school and post-secondary

-Average above 75% in gr 10, 11 or 12 = \$

-Average above 80% in gr 10, 11 or 12 = \$\$

Rutherford Scholarship

High School - Graduated after April 1, 2008

When to Apply for the Rutherford Scholarship

You should apply for the Alexander Rutherford Scholarship for High School Achievement after being accepted into a post-secondary institution and registering in full-time studies, typically starting in early August when the new scholarship year begins. Applications are submitted through the Alberta Student Aid online system and must be completed for the correct scholarship year (e.g., 2025-2026).

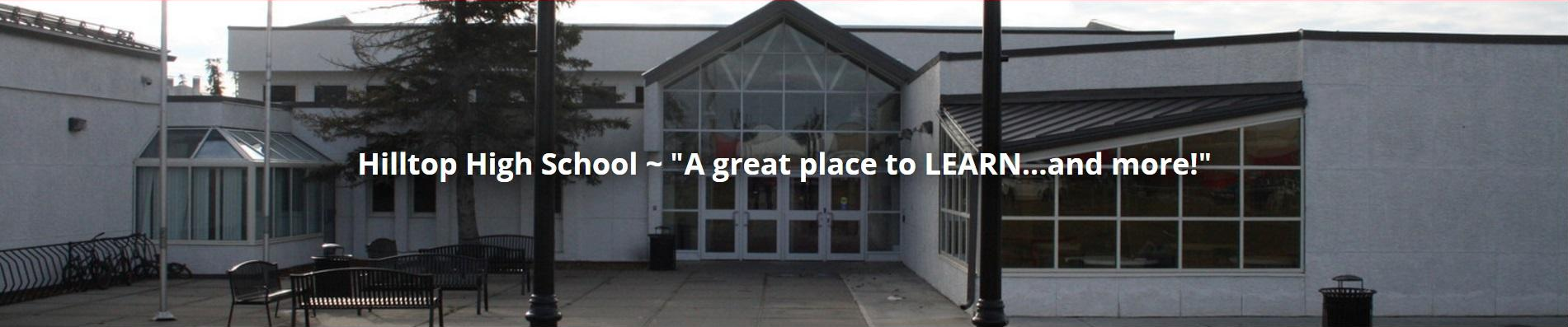
